	Please be aware that we have children in school with <u>serious</u> food allergies. To ensure the safety of all of our children please avoid sending your child to school with anything that contains nuts this includes sandwiches containing peanut butter or chocolate spread.
	As the weather hopefully continues to improve, please think about sending your child with a sunhat, clearly labelled with their name, and ensure that all the garments that children quickly remove when the sun comes out are also

labelled.

Children <u>must not</u> bring suncream to school (or nursery): please apply it before school.
